CONTEST ENTRY GUIDE

ELIGIBILITY

- The contest is open to students of any nationality attending an international school in Johor.
- There are two categories:
 - a) **JUNIOR CATEGORY:**
Below 13 years of age as of 6 November 2018.
 - b) **SENIOR CATEGORY:**
Between 13 and 18 years of age as of 6 November 2018.

ENTRY SPECIFICATIONS

- Each contestant can submit up to three entries.
- Entries should reflect the theme of the contest. Students must submit their photos together with a description explaining why they think it meets the theme of "Precious Family Moment".
- All entries must be at least 6MB in file size and in JPEG format. Dropbox or WeTransfer is recommended to send images with file sizes over 10MB.
- Photos can be in colour or black and white.

HOW TO ENTER

- Each entry must be submitted with a completed entry form, downloadable at www.ExpatGo.com/my/photo-contest.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

- The top 50 pictures, selected by the judges, will be displayed at an event which will take place on the afternoon of 17 November 2018 at the The Avira Sales Gallery

in Johor. Further details will be provided to each shortlisted contestant.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Photos submissions will be judged based on adherence to theme, creativity and composition.
- The judges' decision is final.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Photos that are manipulated electronically will be disqualified.
- Each student may submit up to three images with a separate entry form for each image.
- Each entry form must be signed by a parent, guardian or teacher, confirming that the photo is an original photo taken by the student to the best of their knowledge.
- Contestants agree that all photos submitted may be published by E&O, TEG and supporting sponsors in its various publications, websites and/or marketing materials with appropriate photographer credit, but without notice or further compensation.
